

## Bogle Petite Sirah 2018

A staff and customer favourite for those who love rich, peppery reds. First produced in 1978 by the Bogle family, this Petite Sirah is considered Bogle's "heritage" varietal. On the nose, luscious boysenberry is evident along with touches of black pepper and herbs. Trademark inky and jammy tones fill the mouth with ripe fruit and berries. The voluptuous finish lingers with toasty oak and lush fruit. 14.5% Our family sources grapes from some of the best vineyards across the state. These grapes complement those from our estate vineyards in Clarksburg, Lodi and the Sierra Foothills. To ensure the continued quality of our wines year

We welcome beneficial flora, insects and animals - like the free-roaming sheep honoured on this bottle - alongside our organic vines to boost earth's own vitality and resilience. The result: wines that are perfectly in tune with nature. This Cabernet Sauvignon epitomises balance with a juicy palate of ripe pomegranate, cherry and blackberry and underscored by a decadent thread of rich dark chocolate and leather. Soft tannins are framed by a subtle suggestion of oak in this complex expression of our organic fruit. Jeff Cichocki, Winemaker Juicy and bright with a punch of blackberry and stewed plum fruit right from the off. A dusty tannic backbone holds it all together right through to the long, memorable finish. Perfect with rare red meat, or a plate of sausages.

McManis Viognier 2020 13.5%

In 1990 Ron and his wife Jamie, bought their first vineyard and in 1995 McManis Family Vineyards was formed with the purpose-built winery arriving by the end of the Millennium. Now the McManis family owns over 2,600 acres between the Ripon area and Lodi in California's northern interior region. *Nose*This wine is filled with big, bright fruit aromas of pear and peach.

These families still grow Zinfandel the old way - head trained and untrellised - just as their grandparents did over a century ago. These old vines produce the exceptional quality found in Brazin Zinfandel concentrated and bold, with strong depth of character, robust aromas and flavors of rich black fruit and mocha with hints of black pepper.

## District 7 Pinot Noir

The 2019 Pinot Noir delivers the subtle elegance that can only come from sustainably farmed, cold-climate vineyards. Key aromatics include cherries, plums and raspberries with notes of mocha, vanilla and smoky oak. The palate is rich, smooth and silky with a lingering bright red fruit finish.
